

2023 Norman Nachtrieb Award UIC Chemistry Scholarship Application

The Norman Nachtrieb Award "for scientific promise" is given annually to one continuing sophomore, junior, or senior majoring in Chemistry (BA or BS) or Biochemistry BS. The award carries a prize of \$750. Please note that all final award amounts and how they will be distributed will be determined by the Office of Student Financial Aid on the basis of your unmet financial need for the 2023-2024 academic year and other relevant factors.

The student must have at least a 3.00 GPA and must turn in the completed application to the Department of Chemistry. The award is in memory of Norman Nachtrieb, a member of the UIC Chemistry faculty from 1986-1991. Norman Nachtrieb was a professor at the University of Chicago. After retiring there, he came to UIC and taught general chemistry for six years while collaborating with Prof. Wade Freeman on a textbook.
